

# Copy of Letter set out to all on the electoral roll of LUND Parish.

21<sup>st</sup> July 2020

Dear Friends,

In order to welcome you back into our church for public worship commencing on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2020, we will have to introduce the following measures:

- The Eucharist will be celebrated at 9.30am on Sundays. To adhere to regulations, no more than 30 people can attend the service. Two metre distancing rules will be in place that must always be respected
- By law we must record the names and telephone numbers of people attending worship, so that should an outbreak occur we have a track and trace system in place to prevent the outbreak spreading
- Thus, a booking system will be in place to make sure we do not exceed these numbers and ensure we are not in a position where we must turn anyone away from church. Please telephone Karen Whelan **07734 924730**, - should the list be full, you will automatically be placed on the list for the following week's service.
- In order to attend the service all members of the congregation must wear a face covering.
- On arrival at church you will be asked to sanitise your hands and wait to be escorted to a pew. Not all pews will be utilised, and pews will be occupied from the front to the rear. Please leave 2m clearance should there be someone ahead of you.
- Please note that resources for children have had to be removed from church so please bring some quiet toys that children can play with in the pew during the service.
- If you wish to use the toilet, hands must be sanitised before and thoroughly washed after using the facility
- There will be no singing or sharing of the peace
- Communion will be distributed in a strict order that will be explained at the start of each service.

- You must remain in your pew at the end of the service so that the sidespersons can help you safely leave the building working from the rear first.
- Please do not block the doors by lingering in the church grounds to chat.
- Following the service, the church will be locked for 72 hours in line with guidance received.

These rules must be followed to secure the health and safety of both yourself and our church community. For those of you who continue to feel safer watching online, the service will be videoed and shared on Facebook.
